# **End of Year Dance Star Showcase Notice**

## **DROP OFF & PICK UP PROCESS**

**Step 1:** Please bring your child to the venue dressed in their costume.

**Step 2:** The venue has an extremely large carpark that will accommodate all families and once finding a park please make your way to the foyer where you will be greeted by staff and production volunteers that will escort your child to the backstage area where we will prepare them for the rehearsal.

Please assure you allow enough time for parking and dropping off your child as the times listed above indicate the rehearsal starting time, not arrival time.

Please note that we hold the safety of all students at high regard, therefore only approved volunteers and staff are permitted backstage. If you would like to help backstage, please refer to the section "Parent/Guardian Volunteers"

**Step 3:** Due to a tight schedule the rehearsal will commence on time and all students will have the opportunity to perform on stage making them feel extra confident for the day of the performance.

We ask that parents wait in the foyer, as once your child is finished, we will bring them straight out to you to avoid them waiting around. This will differ on the day of the performance as all students will remain backstage for the duration of the showcase and will be collected at the end. This process allows parents to enjoy the full performance and more importantly ensure that every performer has the same level of support from families in the audience.

We know that little people can become very thirsty and hungry, and we therefore ask that on the day of the rehearsal only a drink bottle is brought however with the performance timeframe a little longer, a healthy snack is also suggested. ### PERFORMANCE PRESENTATION

Our end of year showcase is a professional production, and it is important that our performers presentation is unified. We therefore ask that all Dance Star students have neat and tidy hair. Hair is to be up and off their face in a bun, ponytail, pigtails, any style that suits your child as long as we can see their gorgeous faces!

No make-up is required for the performance as we prefer to see their natural beauty. In the instance you do apply make-up, we suggest a few practice sessions prior to the performance if you are going to apply lipstick as it can often smudge all over their face and costume before going on stage.

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### **COSTUMES**

All students are measured for costumes in Term 3 and will be distributed over the course of term 4. Costumes will be tried on in class and any issues will be rectified. Our costumes are purchased from numerous Australian and International websites and not custom made, therefore we will do our very best to find the right size to fit your child. Some costumes are meant to be tightly fitted whilst others loose and with some of them feeling uncomfortable due to the fabric and or embellishments. Please note that this does not mean it doesn't fit, we will certainly exchange or make alterations to any costumes we feel necessary.

A costume notice will be provided for each class and will include any additional items that may need to be purchased, such as shoes, socks or accessories. The amount allocated for each costume needs to cover numerous costs such as the costume, freight, administration, etc and therefore may not allow for us to include all items however we certainly will do our very best to work within the budget set.

As of term 3, week 10 we are unable to make any changes to your enrolment for the remainder of the year due to showcase preparation.

#### **Tickets**

Tickets for the end of year showcase will be available for purchase on <u>Friday 20<sup>th</sup> October</u> at 9am via Try booking (week 2 of Term 4). A link will be posted closer to the date via our email marketing, on the Band App, Facebook & Instagram. Tickets will sell fast, as in previous years they have SOLD OUT!! Therefore please, get in early to avoid disappointment.

The venue has 2 seating areas to choose from. Please note that access to the tiered seating areas requires you to walk upstairs.

ROWS A to ROWS H = Flat Floor Seating ROWS I to ROWS Z = Tiered Seating

Please be careful to check that you are purchasing tickets for the correct Showcase as there are no refunds available.
